The company has recently developed an innovative safety sensor system with European patents pending.



After contacting WMCCE, the company was put in touch with CE Marking Association which is managed by Wemtech. CE Marking Association was established under a national initiative by the DTI to transfer knowledge in all aspects of the CE Directives and product legislation from Electro-Magnetic Compatibility (EMC), to Low Voltage (LV).
